What is the Homeless Action Committee?

HAC seeks to end homelessness in Albany by focusing on its root causes, and providing services to people who are homeless. HAC operates an Outreach Van program which provides basic aid-food, clothes, blankets, human compassion, and transportation for persons who live on the streets. We also operate permanent housing which provides a home to homeless people with alcoholism who had been living on the streets for years and who have been unable to stay sober.

SLEEP-A-THON REGISTRATION, PROCEDURES, & INFO

1. Participants in this event agree to spend at least **1 hour** in the park. We hope you will sign up for additional hours.
2. The Sleep-a-thon will be held from 5P-12A. It will be held in Townsend Park (corner of Henry Johnson Blvd. & Central Ave., Albany)
3. HAC has a **goal** of raising \$20,000 with this event which will benefit HAC's permanent housing project and HAC's Outreach Van. Each participant should aspire to collect **at least \$100.00**, which **will help us meet our goal**.
4. Bring your pledge form and any pre-paid pledges to this event. When you first arrive, go to the **Social Justice Center- 33 Central Ave** (across from park) **to register**.
